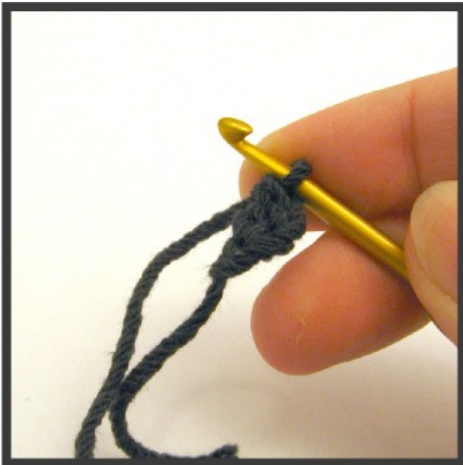


Ninja Tie Tutorial



ch 3



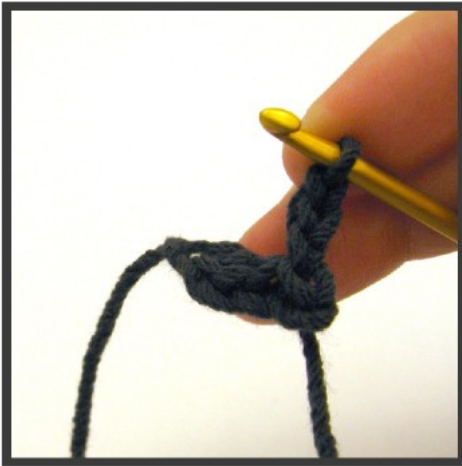
dc 1 in first ch st



ch 2



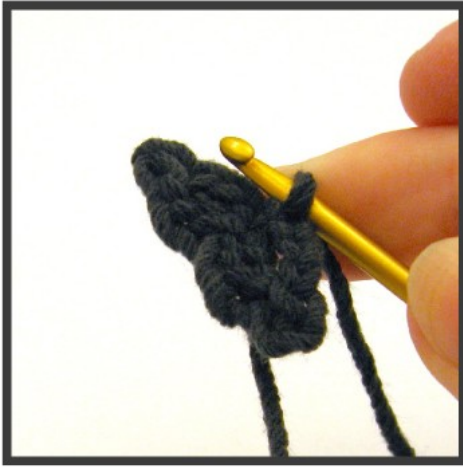
sl st in front 2 loops of dc



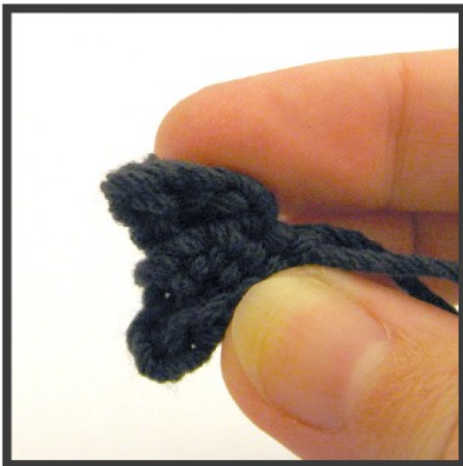
ch 3



sl st in same ch as dc



Repeat the previous steps to make the second half of the tie. It doesn't look like much right now-- it will take some shaping.



Fold the two points of the tie inwards. The stitches should pivot a bit around the first chain stitch. You may need to pull on the yarn ends a bit if your first stitch loosened as you worked.



It helps to run a few stitches through the tie to hold it into the desired shape.



The finished tie should look something like this.



An alternate, less fussy way to work the ninja tie is as follows:

ch 3, dc 1 in the first ch st, ch 2, sl st in the front two loops of the prev. dc, ch 2, sl st in the same two front loops as the last sl st, ch 2, sl st in the same space as the dc, fasten off
